Wiang Pa Pao Lahu Hostel History

In 1985, Mr. Aaron Lee and Mr. Sakda Hasuwan members of the Thailand Lahu Baptist Convention (TLBC), made a donation of 10,000 baht (\$323) each to rent land to build a hostel that would provide a place for hill tribe children from remote mountain villages to stay while attending Thai local government schools. Black and Red Lahu (Christians / Non-Christians) villagers also donated 200 baht (\$6) per family. With a total of 50,000 baht (\$1,613) deposit the children's home was opened in 1986. Bamboo huts were constructed for the children to live. There were 80 - 90 children.

Later in 1990, Mr. Sakda Hasuwan contacted Rev. Dr. Paul Lewis (American Baptist Missionary) who contacted the headquarters of Kindernothilfe e.V (KNH). Kindernothilfe agreed to provide assistance of 500,000 baht (\$16,129) to purchase the land, the land-owner informed TLBC that the land area was around 9 rai (3.5 acres), but when the purchased was completed, the government land officials surveyed 13 rai plus (5 acres). At that time 120 students stayed at the hostel.

Executive Summary

The budget year of July 2021- June 2022 started in June 2021 with the progression of buildings / facilities improvements before the arrival of students. Additionally, more new students came to enroll on June 29, which brought the numbers up to 32 students (12 old students & 20 new students). This is an increase of 10 students compared to last years. The first semester, year 2021 started in July (normally May), later than a normal school semester due to another Covid-19 outbreak. Other June / July activities included planning with tutors the math and English classes, monitoring the chicken egg and other agricultural projects, and conducting the WPP hostel parents /student's orientation. This year we had more parents attend because of the increase of students and parent's having more interest in where their children are staying. During this event the ITDF staff conducted interviews with students' parents with most of the parents expressing their gratefulness for receiving their children. They were impressed with life skills projects, tutoring courses, and the improved facilities.

Despite restriction of travelling during Covid-19 outbreak. Students were able to study at school by limiting the number of students in a class and social distancing. The bible study course conducted by hostel parents as well as English tutoring course by local teachers in WPP continued and went well. Lahu tradition and Math courses will be started in November during the second semester. The chicken egg project continued with 30 new added hens which are expected to produce more eggs for hostel income generation. The hostel Management Project Coordinator held a Hostel committee meeting in July with hostel parents, 2 student parents, and 2 student representatives to discuss hostel operations. Besides hostel committee meetings, the OC committee has closely monitored and discussed the progress

of Suri's kids-WPP hostel. It has been concluded that next quarter some improvements on the water system which was installed 32 years be addressed.

In conclusion, Suri's Kids-WPP hostel operations has improved over the first year. There are more students enrolled, improved facilities, more interest from parents, and has the feeling as being one family.
